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GENERAL BUSINESS:

State Champiorships.

Catering.

Risk Analysis.

Peter Norrie has agreed to undertake this exercise as he has done on previous occasions.

F2B Score Tabulation.

Peter Norrie to the fore again has agreed to provide a PC for the purpose. Joan McIntyre to look after programme.

F2B Judges

The meeting was advised that Murray Howell may be available. Hon. Secretary to seek confirmation from Ken Dowell whether or not he will be standing.

New F2B Rules

There is now a need to weigh models to determine pull test and timing is also an issue that has to be attended. John McIntyre to attend.

Centre of Circle mark for F2B.

Bill Swan raised the issue. Reference to rules determined that no specific wording relates to centre of circle marking in the current FAI Rules, but reference is clearly made to "entry into flight circle".

Trophies.

The meeting was advised that Brian Eather has the matter in hand.

Combat Events.

Peter Norrie informed the meeting that statistics support the mandatory wearing of safety helmets.

First Aid Kit

After general discussion initiated by Peter Norrie, Peter was authorised by a motion moved by John McIntyre and seconded by Paul Turner to acquire a suitable kit with cost to be left to his discretion. Hon. Treasurer to be authorised to cut a cheque for the required amount as soon as the amount is known.

CLAS Banner.

General discussion and it was agreed that it would be a good idea to have a CLAS banner to display at the event. Hon. Secretary to ascertain cost.

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GENERAL BUSINESS Contd.

CLAS Web Site.

This has been an unresolved issue for some time. Ross Boyd was present at the meeting and after advising the cost (\$47.95 site cost for 2 years and \$9.90 per month) and structure generally

agreed to establish and manage the site. There was unanimous approval and gratitude that at last CLAS will have a properly organised web site.

Agenda MAAA Conference 2006

John Elias will be attending the forthcoming conference and raised a number of issues for discussion.

The MAAA will establish a separate account for field acquisition funds. However, there are no additional funds at the moment.

There is an agenda item to increase the grant for running Nationals event from \$5,000 to \$10,000. The meeting indicated support for that proposal.

Rocketry as a new addition to MAAA to be allowed a trial period for 1 year.

2008 Nationals open to offers to host. CLAS would support in principle NSW hosting the event.

Discussion generally on split Nationals and comment in Conference Agenda re Radio Control separate Nationals. Nothing to be resolved at this time.

General opposition to participation in Nationals as a prerequisite to inclusion in National Team due to distance when Nationals held in Perth or Darwin.
